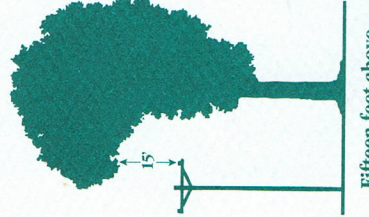
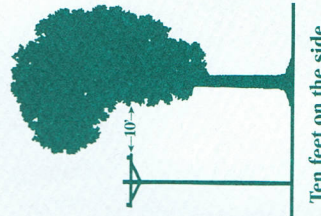
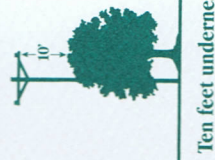


In the coming weeks, Con Edison contractors will be trimming trees in your neighborhood. Tree limb interference and fallen tree limbs are the leading causes of power outages during storms. This work is necessary to ensure safe and reliable electric service for you and your neighbors.

We may or may not need to trim trees along the streets around your home. Our inspectors will be in your neighborhood to assess whether trimming is required. If trimming is necessary, we hire professional, qualified tree trimmers who follow the International Society of Arboriculture pruning guidelines. We make very effort to minimize the impact on the appearance, health, and stress to trees. You may be contacted by one of our notification foresters to discuss this work.

When it comes to planting trees, it's important to pick the right tree for the right place. You need to consider how large a tree will be when fully grown.
