

# **ELECTION NEWS FROM THE TOWN CLERK'S OFFICE**

## **PRIMARY FOR DEMOCRATIC – INDEPENDENCE AND CONSERVATIVE PARTIES – TUESDAY – SEPTEMBER 15**

### **GENERAL ELECTION IS TUESDAY – NOVEMBER 3rd**

#### **Voter Registration**

The Town Clerk's office at 321 Bedford Road in Bedford Hills, will be open on Tuesday evenings during the month of September as well as October 6th from 5 PM to 7 PM and normal business hours Monday through Friday for voter registration.

Applications for registration to vote in the Primary must be postmarked not later than August 21<sup>st</sup> and received by the board of elections not later than August 26<sup>th</sup>.

The deadline to register to vote in the General elections is Friday October 9th and applications must be received by the board of elections not later than October 14<sup>th</sup>.

In order to register to vote, you must:

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be 18 years of age by the date of the general, primary or other election in which you want to vote
- Live at your present address at least 30 days before an election
- Not be in jail or on parole for a felony conviction
- Not claim the right to vote elsewhere.

#### **Please note the following:**

- If you made a change to your voter registration through "Motor Voter", please check with the Clerk's office, 666-4534 OR the Board of Elections, 995-5700 to ensure that the change has been made.
- You may be asked for identification when going to vote, so please remember to bring a form of identification with you to the polls.
- All polling locations in the Town of Bedford are handicap accessible. However if you have a special need, please contact the Town Clerk's office so that we can assist you.

#### **Absentee Ballots**

Forms to request an absentee ballot can be obtained at the Town Clerks office but must be sent directly to the Westchester County Board of Elections, 25 Quarropas Street, White Plains, New York 10601.

#### **Primary Election:**

Last day to postmark application for ballot last is September 8<sup>th</sup>.

Last day to apply in person for the ballot is September 14<sup>th</sup>.

Last day to postmark the ballot is September 14<sup>th</sup> and it must be received by the Board of Elections no later than September 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Last day to deliver ballot in person to the Board of Elections is September 15<sup>th</sup>.

#### **General Election:**

Last day to postmark application or letter of application for ballot is October 27th.

Last day to apply in person for the ballot is November 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Last day to postmark the ballot is November 2nd and it must be received by the Board of Elections no later than November 10th.

Last day to deliver ballot in person to the Board of Elections is November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

#### **Election Inspectors**

The Westchester Board of Elections is always looking for election inspectors. Election Inspector's are paid \$225.00 and the requirements are:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must be enrolled in either the Republican or Democratic Party
- Hours are from 5:30 am – 9:00 pm.
