Proof of Publication was presented and ordered filed. The public notice was published in the Bedford Pound Ridge Record Review on January 16, 2009.

Chief Menzel explained the background for this request and discussed the report from Adler Consulting (Traffic Engineers) that Commissioner of Public Works Kevin Winn had presented at the January 6, 2009 Town Board meeting, noting that this stop sign was one of the recommendations for traffic calming on this street.

Mrs. Roberts commented that she had received an email requesting a stop sign at the intersection of McLain Street and West Patent Road going east and the recommendation from Mr. Adler had been for the three-way stop.

LOCAL LAW NO. 3 - 2009 TO AMEND CHAPTER 117 OF THE TOWN CODE

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Bedford Amends Chapter 117, Article I of the Code of the Town of Bedford regarding Parking and Traffic Regulations as follows:

§ 117-1. Main arteries of travel.

The following streets listed under Column A below are hereby designated as main arteries of travel, and all vehicles, before entering same from public highways set forth opposite same as listed under Column B below, shall come to a full stop or yield the right-of-way as indicated by signs, unless otherwise directed by a peace officer or signal:
