RESOLVED that the Town Board does hereby adopt the legislation as follows:

LOCAL LAW 2-2009  
TO SET IMPOUNDMENT FEES UPON REDEMPTION OF DOGS  
IMPOUNDED IN THE TOWN OF BEDFORD

A LOCAL LAW to change the fee for the redemption of impounded of dogs seized within the Town of Bedford.

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Bedford as follows:

Section 1: In accordance with Agriculture and Markets Law §118, the Town of Bedford is authorized to set an impoundment fee for the redemption of dogs seized and maintained by the Town of Bedford.

Section 2: Upon the first impoundment of a dog, the owner may redeem the dog in accordance with the provisions of Agricultural and Markets Law §118 and further provided that the owner pays an impoundment fee to the Town of Bedford in the amount of Thirty Two (\$32) Dollars.

Section 3. After the first redemption, upon an additional impoundment of any dog owned by a dog owner, that owner may redeem the dog in accordance with the provisions of Agricultural and Markets Law §118 and further provided that the owner pays an impoundment fee to the Town of Bedford in the amount of Sixty Four (\$64) Dollars.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect on January 6, 2009.
