A public hearing was held by the Town Board of the Town of Bedford to consider Local Law #1-2010, an amendment to Chapter 117 of the Code of the Town of Bedford entitled "Parking" to change the Code to add metered parking spaces to a portion of the lot on the west side of Railroad Avenue Route near the intersections of Route 117 and Harris Road was held on May 18, 2010 at the Town Offices, 321 Bedford Road, Bedford Hills, New York. Proof of Publication was presented and ordered filed. The public notice was published in the Bedford Pound Ridge Record Review on May 7, 2010.

Mrs. Roberts asked Kevin Winn, Commissioner of Public Works to explain the proposal. Mr. Winn advised that if enacted, this local law would change twelve (12) parking spaces on Railroad Avenue to be sold as metered spaces for commuter parking.

Mrs. Roberts opened the floor to public comment and there was none.

RESOLVED that the Town Board does hereby adopt and enact the following legislation:

LOCAL LAW NO. 1 - 2010 TO AMEND CHAPTER 117 OF THE TOWN CODE

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Bedford Amends Chapter 117, Article I of the Code of the Town of Bedford regarding Parking and Traffic Regulations as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 117, Article I regarding Parking in Bedford Hills is hereby amended to allow overnight parking on the west side of Railroad Avenue near the intersections of Route 117 and Harris Road, as follows:

§ 117-1. Enumeration of restrictions and restricted areas.

Parking or standing of vehicles within and upon the hereinafter designated streets, public places and portions thereof shall be restricted and/or regulated as follows:

(Area known as Section 34, Lots 178, 179 and 179 A1 on the Tax Assessment Map of the Town of Bedford, being a portion of the rights-of-way of the Harlem Division of the former New York Central Railroad and New York State Route No. 117, bounded by Railroad Avenue, the Harlem Division tracks of former New York Central Railroad and New York State Route No. 117): Current parking sticker issued by Town of Bedford required to be affixed to the left rear side window of vehicle.
